- To defend the noble Alliance of knowledge and virtue, in the service of Piety and Letters.

Contemplate; pass through the heart, so that we do not forget our reason for being in the Church, in the world, and that we can respond to that for which we are called, living in creative fidelity to our origin, as part of this religious family in the Church.

A family, which in the year 2020 rejoices because of the celebration of 75 years of educational presence in Seville, of the 50 years of our arrival to Colombia, and of the 50 years of Calasancian presence of the Daughters of the Divine Shepherdess in La Coruña.
